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Introduction about Lakshmi Devi Shroff Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya

Lakshmi Devi Shroff Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya, the only Sanskrit college of Jharkhand offering Acharya (Masters) Degree in Sanskrit, is situated at B. Deoghar, a sacred place of Vaidyanath, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas (Manokamanalinga). It was established in the year 1979 and was included in ASM of the Ministry of Education & Culture, Government of India in the year 1984. It is affiliated to Central Sanskrit University.

Lakshmi Devi Shroff Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya provides education from Prakshastri to Acharya: Prakshastri (equivalent to Intermediate, Two-year course), Shastri (equivalent to Bachelor Degree, Three-year course) & Acharya (equivalent to Master Degree, Two-year course) in the subjects of Sahitya (Literature), Vyakarana (Grammar), Jyotish (Astrology) & Veda. To cope with the modern situation not only traditional subjects but also modern subjects like English, Hindi, Political Science, Computer Science & Environment Science are also taught here. It has hostel facility for the poor students and the students coming from remote area.

Strength of the Institution (महाविद्यालयस्य सामर्थ्यम्)

We are fortunate that our college is situated at a very sacred place of Baba Vaidyanath, one of the twelve Jyotirlingas (Manokamanalinga) where Sanskrit lovers and the person having curiosity to know Sanskrit reside. Sanskrit language can flourish here very easily. We have been trying our level best for about forty years to expand the area of Sanskrit and, to some extent, we have been successful.

Our institution is situated in the heart of the town where there is no problem of communication. Person can reach here very easily. There are so many villages in the nearby areas from where students can come.

It is a religious place so, Sanskrit loving people from different parts of India come here who are, some time, ready to donate for the development of Sanskrit which can help in the development of our Institution.

Weakness of the Institution (महाविद्यालयस्य निर्बलता)

Our institution belongs to a very poor state like Jharkhand. The area where it is situated is also very poor, backward and deprived of essential facilities. Students who get admission here are mostly sons of farmers. They do not have sufficient money to continue their study further. Most of them are not even in a position to pay fees. This is the reason that they fail to continue their study. They cannot afford to live in town. They need hostel at very low fee. But we do not have sufficient accommodation for more than forty five students. We do not have hostel facility for Girls, so the girls from remote area fail to get admission here. Not only this we do not have sufficient no. of teaching and non-teaching staff, class rooms, well furnished library, well equipped computer lab, well furnished administration block etc.

Opportunity of the Institution (महाविद्यालयस्यावसरः)

We are fortunate that our institution belongs to an area where Sanskrit can flourish because Sanskrit loving people live here and religious persons from all over India come here. If the facilities like boys hostel, girl's hostel etc. are properly provided the no. of students will grow very fast.

Challenges of the Institution (महाविद्यालयस्य समाह्वानम्)

To cope with modern situation we have some challenges which we will try to face in ensuing years:

- **Lack of awareness:** We will have to go every nook and corner of this area to promote Sanskrit language and create awareness about Sanskrit language in the mind of people which will, ultimately, help in promoting and expanding Sanskrit language.
- **Lack of sufficient no. of teaching and non-teaching staff:** In coming years we will have to try to increase the no. of Teaching and Non-Teaching staff for smooth functioning of our institution which will lead to the promotion of Sanskrit language.
- **Lack of proper infrastructure:** In coming five years we will try to develop our whole infrastructure which will help us in increasing the no. of students etc.
- **Quality Development:** We will try to develop the quality of our Teaching and Administration.

- **Backwardness of this area:** We will visit remote area and create awareness about Sanskrit language and its importance and opportunities.

Attribute 1 - Curriculum

Summary: This unit has seven sub-units that require many types of information. So far as our institution is concerned, we have obtained feedback on the syllabus and its transaction from students, teachers and alumni. We analyzed the collected data and took action where ever needed. So far as flexibility of our curriculum is concerned it is very flexible. Students have been given elective/optional courses like Hindi, Computer Science, English, Political Science, Psychology, Tarkasopana etc.

We have provided ABC ID of 55 out of 125 students to our University for credit transferor. Not only this we have career counseling cell that provided guidance to our students. Students got benefits and became successful in getting admission in B.Ed, M.A. etc. Some of them became successful in getting Government Jobs also.

Attribute 2 - Research & Innovation Outcomes

Summary: This unit has ten sub-units in which we have to provide the information about the qualification of our teachers and about their academic related activates. At present this institution has seven permanent teachers. All of them are Ph. D holders and most of them are NET/JRF qualified. They have taken part in many of the Seminars/Workshop/Symposium/Conference etc. and presented their research papers there. Not only this, some of them have published their research paper in UGC refereed journals. Some of the teachers have published their books also with ISBN No. One of the teachers has done the work of editing a book.

Attribute 3 - Co-curricular, Extra-curricular and Sustainability Engagements

Summary: This unit has six sub-units requiring information related to the extra-curricular actives of the students of our institutions. Students of our institution have participated very actively in Sanskrit Olympiad and Geeta Olympiad and got 1st, 2nd and 3rd position in state level.

Students of our institution took part in 12th Youth Festival organized by Central Sanskrit University, Shree Sadashiva Campus, Puri, Odisha in which one Shastri 3rd year student named Raju Pandey got 3rd prize in Rangoli. Besides it our students took part in 2nd Zonal Drama Festival organized by Central Sanskrit University, Ekalavya Campus, Agartala in which three of our students got 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize. Not only this, we have been organizing Sanskrit Week celebration every year. In which competition is held and prizes are distributed.

Attribute 4 - Sustainability Outcomes including Green Initiatives

Summary: This unit has seven sub-units requiring various information. So far as water management is concerned, we have one bore well, two open wells and one pond in our campus premises that help in maintaining water level.

So far as donation is concerned Rs.147300.00 has been donated to Central Sanskrit University Yuva Nidhi Kosh, New Delhi by Teaching and Non-Teaching staff of our institution and Library Assistant of our institution Mr. Chandeshwar Yadav has donated Rs.5000.00 to Lakshmi Devi Shroff Adarsh Sanskrit Mahavidyalaya, Deoghar, Jharkhand.

We have conducted a number of programmes for the Indian Language Promotion like Sanskrit Saptah, Matrubhasa Diwas etc. Our students have also been engaged for the promotion of language in the society.

Attribute 5 - Teaching & Learning

Summary: This unit has six sub-units requiring information related to Teaching Learning Process. So far as pedagogical approaches are concerned, we have used teaching learning techniques like memorization of Koshas, Sutras, and Karikas. Our students have also under gone internship programme.

We have continuous evaluation system of our institution conducted at different intervals using different methods like MCQ, Open Book Exam, Case study, Projects, Assignments, Group Discussions, Seminar presentation etc.

Our support for differential learning needs include inclusive remedial Teaching, Skill Based Teaching, Language barrier Remedial, Individualized Teacher interventions etc.

Pass percentage of Students of our institution is good. Almost all students passed the examination during last three years.

Attribute 6 - Governance and Administration

Summary: This unit has ten sub-units requiring information regarding Governance and Administration. Our institution has vision, mission and objectives uploaded on our college website. There is MOU of our institution with Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi. All statutory compliances like CSU Act, Adarsh Scheme guidelines etc are available on our website.

All the staff of our institution have Samarth ID. 55 out of 123 students have ABC ID. Scholarship, Salary and other payments are done through digital system.

We have Student & Employ Welfare system like NPS (Under Consideration), Health & life insurance scheme (Under Consideration), Grievance handling mechanism

like Woman Anti Sexual Harassment Cell, Anti Raging Cell, Grievance Redressal Cell etc. and Quality Assurance System like IQAC.

So far as no. of court cases in our institution is concerned there is only one case pending in our institution.

Attribute 7 - Student Outcomes

Summary: This unit has eight sub-units requiring information regarding Students outcomes. During last three years more than twelve students of our college got government job. Out of thirty four students twenty four students progressed to higher education. More than seventeen students are self employed during last three years.

Students of our institution took part in many events like 2nd Zonal Drama Festival and 12th Youth Festival and got three prizes during last three years.

So far as enrollment ratio, Graduation rate and percentage of seats filled against the seats reserved for various categories (SC/ST/OBC/Divyangjan/EWS etc.) is concerned the details are mentioned in prescribed format.

Attribute 8 - Faculty Resources

Summary: This unit has twelve sub-units requiring information regarding Faculty Resources. Our institution follows all the process of recruitment set by UGC 2018. Our faculty members are from different parts of India like Odisha, Madhya Pradesh, Bihar, Uttarakhand, Jharkhand and West Bengal. The pay and allowances are as per UGC norms except PGT. Faculty student ratio in our institution is 01:17.58.

Dr. Basanta Kumar Mudra did the Post Graduate Diploma in research Methodology, Manuscript, Paleography and Calligraphy and at present he is doing the work of editing related to a Manuscript (Bhadrasmartalata).

Our institution has conducted four Seminar/Vyakshyanamala/Workshop during last three years.

Attribute 9 - Infrastructure

Summary: This unit has seven sub-units requiring information regarding Infrastructure. Our institution has Boys Hostel, Seminar Hall, Wi-Fi Facilities, Dhyanamandiram, Yogashala, Gurukula style open class room, Jyotish lab, Sports facilities etc. It has high speed and reliable internet connectivity, Virtual lab, Digital class rooms etc. We have eight class rooms, nine computers and 24 CCTV. Three class rooms are connected with CCTV.

The institution has one library in which there are 3693 books available in different languages like Sanskrit, Hindi, English, Bengali, Urdu, Pali and Prakrit. Teachers, Students and Outcomers visit our library regularly. It has E-library with E-journal, E-books.

Attribute 10 - Financial Resources

Summary: This unit has fourteen sub-units requiring information regarding Financial Resources. Our Institution receives fund from Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi in different heads like Recurring (Salary, Scholarship, Legal Expenses, TA, DA etc. and non-recurring (Campus Development). Our institution generates internal resources like hostel fee, admission fee etc. It has investment like Fix deposit in the Bank.

Every month we send demand to Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi and we receive fund at the end of the month which is sent to the account of the employees digitally as their salary. We receive money from Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi in different heads and that amount is spent in the respective heads.

At the end of financial year an annual audit report of our institution is prepared by CA. and the same is sent to the Central Sanskrit University, New Delhi for further steps.
